



**Challenge:** When turning the wheel on certain units, mostly conventional, there is a “growl” which seems to be the growl of a power steering pump . . . but is it?

**Possible Cause:** We have seen or should I say heard this and almost changed the pump instead of checking further!

**Solution:** After a thorough check we found the rubber boot for the steering shaft contaminated with dirt and grime and as the wheel was turned, it made the exact sound of a bad power steering pump!

We cleaned the shaft surface and sprayed with silicone and the noise disappeared.
