



Issue: Brake valves do not contain the markings “DEL” for delivery or “SUP” for supply but have numerical markings at the ports.

Solution: Valve markings are being migrated from the old “US” (United States) nomenclature to the new “WW” (World Wide) nomenclature.

Conversion table:

U.S. Port ID	W.W. Port ID
“RES” = Supply	#1
“DEL” = Delivery	#2
“EXH” = Exhaust	#3
“CONT” = Signal	#4
“ACC” = Accessory	#5

WW markings go a step further by specifying rather the port is “Primary”, “Secondary” or “BOTH” by adding a second digit as follows:

- #1 = Primary
- #2 = Secondary
- #3 = BOTH

Examples: #11 = Supply, Primary
 #43 = Control, BOTH (Primary/Secondary)
